Re: Commitment Letter

I am pleased to inform you that the District of Squamish will graciously accept a donation of \$15,000 towards the purchase of a 15 passenger recreation programs vehicle.

Seniors' Centre Society Commitment

- To provide a onetime donation of \$15,000 to the District of Squamish to be put towards the purchase of a 15 passenger van or bus suitable for transporting seniors
- The Society acknowledges the vehicle will be used for various recreation programs including but not limited to seniors programs.

District of Squamish Commitment

- The program vehicle will be owned and operated by the District of Squamish
- The District of Squamish will be responsible for insuring the vehicle for its purpose, and for the ongoing maintenance of the vehicle for the regular life of the vehicle
- The District of Squamish will provide low cost and high value programs for seniors through use of the program vehicle
- The District of Squamish will provide signage on the outside of the program vehicle acknowledging the donation from the Society
- The District of Squamish acknowledges that children in the program vehicle will be supervised at all times.
- The District of Squamish will publish a press release acknowledging the donation of the Seniors' Centre Society for the purchase of the program vehicle
- In deciding which vehicle to purchase, the District of Squamish will take into consideration recommendations from the Society
- The District of Squamish supports the use of volunteer drivers to support low cost high value programs for seniors on the condition that all drivers must meet policy and legislative requirements (e.g. Drivers Abstract, Police Information Check, Class 4 Drivers License)
- If requested, the District of Squamish will provide a tax receipt for the donation.
