THAT District of Squamish staff consult with the Squamish Seniors Centre Society in advance of the District of Squamish entering into a Memorandum of Understanding with Squamish Senior Citizens Home Society to pursue a licence agreement and development of a Seniors Wellness Hub at the Westwinds, located at 38275 Third Avenue.
